The Johnstown Free Medical Clinic (JFMC) has expanded operating hours and will now offer clinical appointments on Tuesdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and Wednesdays from 2 p.m. to 9 p.m.

"The need for additional appointment times has been on-going, and it is our pleasure to be able to serve additional patients and their medical or pharmaceutical needs," said Rosalie Danchanko, Executive Director of the Clinic. "A PA Department of Health grant enabled funding to hire a doctor who will be with us until June and then we will hire a Physician Assistant to continue examining patients during the Clinic's expanded hours."

The Clinic welcomes Dr. Patrick Carroll who joined the Clinic at the end of March and immediately began seeing patients. Thank you Dr. Carroll!

Attention Volunteers: Additional Shifts Needed!

The expansion of Clinic hours requires additional volunteers to fill added shifts. On Tuesdays, Clinic hours have been changed to 9 a.m. until 4 p.m. The two nursing shifts will be needed: from 9 a.m. to Noon and another from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. On Wednesdays, Clinic hours have been expanded to 1 p.m.
