The Johnstown Free Medical Clinic (JFMC) is participating in the Highmark Walk for a Healthy Community presented by Highmark Blue Cross Blue Shield on Saturday, May 31, 2014 at Central Park in downtown Johnstown.

"The Highmark Walk is a major fundraiser for the Clinic and will help us help others obtain the gift of good health," said Rosalie Danchanko, Executive Director of the JFMC. The Clinic provides medical and pharmaceutical services to low income or uninsured residents of the Laurel Highlands.

The event includes a 5K or One-Mile Fun Walk, raffle drawings, games and live entertainment for the

participants. There is no registration fee. However, walkers are encouraged to raise funds for the Free Clinic.
