Highmark walk to benefit 18 nonprofits

The Highmark Walk for a Healthy Community will be held May 31 beginning at Central Park in downtown Johnstown. Registration for the 5K walk will begin at 7:45 a.m., with the walk starting at 9.

A one-mile fun walk will start at 9:15.

The event will benefit 18 local nonprofit organizations that deliver health and human service programs to the community.

Participants select the organization they would like to support when they register.

The organizations are:

The Atrium, The Learning Lamp, Victim Services Inc., Westmont Family Counseling Ministries and YWCA of Greater Johnstown.

There is no registration fee for the walk, but all walkers are being encouraged to raise funds for the organization of their choice.

Those who wish to register can do so online at www.walkforahealthycommunity.org. Food, beverages, music, activities and prize drawings will be available at the conclusion of the walk.

There will be an accessible walkway for strollers and wheelchairs.
